1. With what biblical character do you identify? What about that character attracts you? How has identifying with that character formed your life and faith? Tell that character's story in first person—that is, as if you were him or her.
2. With whom can you share your personal stories? What about that person allows you to trust him or her? Which people in your life share their stories with you? What makes those relationships significant?
3. When has the mystery of life—the numinous—become clearly present for you, like it is for the narrator in Robert Penn Warren's poem? The narrator points to the Divine by describing the sound of geese flying north. How would you describe your experience of the Divine?
